## AIR FIRE CLAY

### **DESCRIPTION:**

Air Fire Clay is the cheaper version of Critter Clay. It is a selfhardening clay. Strong and light with a medium structure. This wet modeling clay has a low shrinkage (0-2%) and is perfect for many everyday sculpting applications. Air Fire Clay is great for art projects in the classroom, club or at home.

### **PROPERTY:**

- ✓ Selfhardening, no ovens needed
- ✓ 1-component, no mixing required
- ✓ Water based
- ✓ Sense of plasticity
- ✓ Gets rock hard
- ✓ Lightweight when fully cured

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:**

- ✓ Ready to go from the bag.
- ✓ Once exposed to the air, Air Fire Clay begins to harden.
- ✓ Use water to wet your fingers and tools to better shape and add detail.
- ✓ Air drying and curing of the sculpture varies with the size of the project and the conditions you are working in. (Drying and curing takes an average of 2-6 days depending on thickness, size and environment).
- ✓ Keep Air Fire Clay in a plastic bag for as long as you don't want it to start to harden.
- ✓ For extra shelf life, you can freeze and thaw Air Fire Clay.
- ✓ Air Fire Clay accepts all paints.
- ✓ Safe for children to use under adult supervision.

### **VARIOUS APPLICATIONS:**

- ✓ Taxidermy (setting a glass eye, inserting an animal's ear, ...)
- ✓ In the classroom and at camp (handprints of children, modeling, ...)
- ✓ Arts, crafts and hobbies

### **TIPS:**

When the clay starts to dry slightly by leaving the bag open, you can rewet the Air Fire Clay, and leave it in the bag overnight. The less water you use, the better the results you will get.
