PAPA'S CLAY

DESCRIPTION:

Papa's Clay is a polymer clay that remains flexible after curing. It has the following advantages:

- ✓ Papa's Clay has a unique texture that is very easy to work with and handle
- ✓ Dirt and dust do not adhere easily
- ✓ High flexibility after curing
- ✓ Just 15 minutes. Bake at 130°C
- ✓ No allergens or toxins

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

Before Papa's Clay can be used, it must be made workable. Clay softens very quickly in your hands due to the warming effect.

- ✓ Hold it in your hands for a minute or two and knead it until it is malleable.
- ✓ If the clay is too hard for you, you can heat it with the hairdryer or a hot air gun.
- ✓ Do not place it in a "Pasta Machine" or similar device to make it soft, but always make it workable first.

Always work with clean hands on a clean surface. Wood and wire supports can be used as base materials for your clay masterpieces.

OUTCOME:

Any home oven is suitable for curing Papa's Clay. Preheat the oven to 130°C/265°F. The curing process takes 15 minutes. If you have more layers, you can bake clay several times.

Do not microwave or cook in water.

BEWARE:

Store Papa's Clay in plastic vacuum bags at room temperature.

WARNING:

This product is only intended for use by children over 8 years old. Younger children should use this clay only under adult supervision. Polymer clay should not be put in the mouth.
